2026 TEE BALL DIVISION RULES

A. T-Ball Rules

1. **Games to be one hour in duration.** When one hour is complete, call the game.
2. Each player will bat once each inning.
3. No outs are recorded.
4. No score is kept.
5. After the 5th game, teams will begin to coach pitch to their own players.
6. If the player does not hit off the coach after four pitches they will then hit off the tee. **There are no additional pitches.**
7. Coaches - A team shall have no more than four adults allowed on the field once the game starts (behind the players). There must be one adult coach in the dugout at all times. All adults in direct contact with players either in game or practice must be background checked by Riviera Little League. Violations of this rule will result in a coaching suspension and/or removal at the discretion of the President.
8. Injuries must be reported to the RLL Safety Officer as soon as possible. Coaches shall work with the RLL Safety Officer to complete the required incident and injury reports.
9. One coach on offense will be at home plate to retrieve balls.
10. All players shall play a defensive position per inning.
11. The coach is required to have the player medical release forms for his team at all practices and games.
12. All players and coaches are expected to conduct themselves in a positive manner at all times. Any coach or player who uses offensive language, *argues with a League official*, or conducts him/herself in an unsportsmanlike manner, may be ejected from the game. If this occurs, the individual in question is subject to the penalties imposed by the RLL Board.
